'Be our eyes and ears' (Whistleblower)

Cancer Council Queensland is committed to operating legally, transparently, and ethically. All supporters are urged to report non-compliant behaviours for further investigation.

REPORTING MISCONDUCT

A Whistleblower is encouraged to report any concerns to the Cancer Council Queensland via our Fundraising Support team or the supporters MyCCQ Partner (Coordinator, Community Engagement). This can be done in person, by phone or in writing (letter/email). All reports will remain confidential.

Whistleblowers will have the option to make a Misconduct Disclosure anonymously or provide their contact details. Cancer Council Queensland, however, encourages Whistleblowers to disclose their name and contact details to assist with the investigation and to allow us to provide updates on the progress and outcomes of the investigation.

Misconduct Disclosures should contain details of:

- The nature of the alleged misconduct
- The person/persons responsible for the misconduct
- The facts on which the Whistleblower's belief that misconduct has occurred
- The nature and whereabouts of any further evidence that would substantiate the Whistleblower's allegations, if known
