We support people from all backgrounds, including First Nations people, LGBTQIA+ communities, people living with disabilities, and those from diverse cultural backgrounds.

The program is open to anyone 18 or over who has been impacted by cancer. You can access up to six sessions with each peer mentor you connect with.
